INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE


The Noble PP BCI Strategic Income Fund of Funds is a conservative managed fund of funds. The objective is to provide the investor with a high level of income combined with relatively low long-term capital growth.

INVESTMENT POLICY

The portfolio complies with prudential investment guidelines to the extent allowed for by the Act. However, to provide a limited level of capital protection, the portfolio's equity exposure may not exceed 40% of the portfolio's net asset value. Investments to be included in the portfolio will, apart from money market instruments and cash, consist of participatory interests and other forms of participation of local and global collective investment schemes, or other similar schemes operated in territories with a regulatory environment which is to the satisfaction of the manager and trustee of a sufficient standard to provide investor protection at least equivalent to that in South Africa and which is consistent with the portfolio's primary objective, investing in equity securities, property securities, non-equity securities, money market instruments, preference shares, listed and unlisted financial instruments, bonds and other interestbearing instruments and securities.

**The investment manager manages the portfolio in line with the following internal maximum exposure restrictions: equity: 25%.



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


